Teach him to be gentle with gentle people and tough with the tough.

Teach him to listen to all men but teach him also to filter all he bears on a screen of truth and take only the good that comes through.

Teach him, if you can, how to laugh when he is sad. Teach him there is no shame in tears. Teach him in scoff at cynics and to beware of too much sweetness.

Teach him to sell his brawn and brain to the highest bidders; but never to put a price tag on his heart & soul.

Teach him to close his ears to a howling mob... and to stand and fight if he thinks he's right.

Treat him gently; but do not cuddle him because only the test of fire makes fine steel.

The Constitution of India

Preamble

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC AND TO SECURE TO ALL ITS CITIZENS:

Justice, social, Economic and Political:

Liberty of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship:

Equality of Status and of opportunity: and to promote among them all

Fraternity assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation:

In our constituent Assembly this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949 do hereby adopt, enact and give to ourselves this Constitution.

Part IV A (Article 51A)

Fundamental Duties

Fundamental Duties-It shall be the duty of every citizen of India.

- (a) to abide by the Constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National flag and the National Anthem:
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideals which inspired our national struggle for freedom:
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India.
- (d) to defend the country and render national service when called upon to do so:
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women:
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture:
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including, forests, lakes, rivers, wildlife and to have compassion for living creatures:
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform:
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence:
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rise to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.
- (k) Who is a parent or guardian, to provide opportunities or education to his child or, as the case may be, ward between age of six and fourteen years.

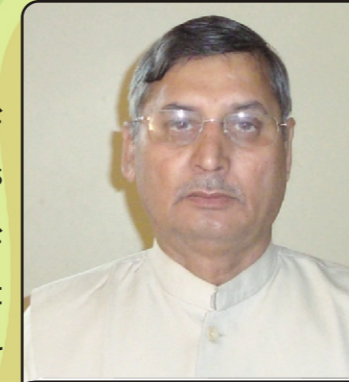

The Aims of Our School

At B.D. Public School, we believe every child has the right to equality of opportunity and access to the whole curriculum. We aim to provide a learning environment for every child which:

- is safe and secure, exciting, stimulating, challenging and relevant.
- develops the confidence and talent of every individuals.
- fosters self esteem, self-awareness and motivates learners.
- promotes the qualities of being resourceful, reflective and resilient, is appropriate and match to individual needs.
- offers a wide range of activities which includes the requirements of the National Curriculum.

Foundation Stage Yrs

These are the early years of education, beginning in the nursery and ending at the reception year when the children will be five years old. The curriculum is divided into six areas of learning although we recognize that in practice many of these areas overlap.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children learn to work together to share and cooperate. They help to develop good self-esteem and confidence. This area is the basis for success in all other areas of the curriculum.

Communication Language and Literacy

Children develop speaking and listening skills in a variety of situations. They begin to read and write and to use information and communication technology (ICT) skills. These are developed through making connections often through play.



Mathematical Development

Children develop skills in mathematics through active learning. This will include counting, sorting, matching, seeking patterns, making connections, recognizing relationships and working with numbers, shapes, space and measures. Mathematical understanding is developed through stories, songs, games and imaginative plays.

Knowledge of the World

Children develop those skills that help them make sense of the world. This includes first-hand experience that encourages exploration, observation, problem-solving critical thinking, decision making and discussion. This forms the foundation for later work in science, design and technology, history, geography and (ICED)

Physical Development

Children develop their skills of co-ordination, control, manipulation and movement. This involves using a range of equipment both in doors and outdoors.

Creative Development

Creativity is fundamental to successful learning. Being creative allows children to make connections between areas of learning and so extend understanding. This area includes art, craft, music, dance, role play and imaginative play.

Discipline

Good behavior is important. Everyone at B.D. Public School is expected to speak and act in a respectful manner and to work to the best of their ability. Children are encouraged to be aware of the responsibilities within the society of the school, to be kind and considerate to other and to respect personal and communal property. Assemblies are used to emphasise our expectations and children are taught a carefully planned programme of PSHE lessons which include behavior for learning.

For inappropriate behavior in or out of the class room, teachers may keep children at playtime or lunch time under supervision. In addition particularly for unacceptable behavior within the class room, children may be removed to another class for a short period time. We also use 'Think Sheet' which is given to the child to take home and reflect on their behavior. This is returned signed by the parents to show they are aware of what has occurred.

For persistent offences, the head teacher will be involved. Parents are kept informed from an early stage to enable them to support our discipline procedure. Parents are able to read our behavior policy on request and a copy of our code of conduct sent home to all parents to share with their children.

Course of Study

Our Institution runs classes right from Nur. To XII strictly according to the syllabus approved by the CBSE, New Delhi. We have started +2 education in science and commerce faculties since 2009-2010 with qualified teachers for +2 section.

There is well equipped compute section for computer education.

Scheme of Studies

For Science and Commerce (+2)

Faculty Candidate may apply for any two of the groups. Admission in a group is subject to availability of vacancy.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is English.

Academic Session

The academic sessions starts from April to March.

Registration

- Registration forms and prospectus can be obtained from the school office on any working day on payment of ₹500/- in cash/cheque. For obtaining forms by post one will have to send ₹550/- through Demand Draft/Money Order in the favour of B.D. PUBLIC SCHOOL payable at Hajipur or Patna.
- The registration fee once paid is not refundable under any circumstances.
- For registration the following testimonials should be attached.
- Proof of date of birth.
- Two copies of previous academic record (for class IV onwards only)
- For class VII onwards:
 - i. School Leaving Certificate Transfer Certificate from a recognized/affiliated school.
 - ii. Marks-sheet of the previous class.
 - iii. Character Certificate/Migration Certificate (if applicable)

The application should reach the school office by **17/01/2020 (Friday)** positively. No application will be entertained thereafter.

Admission And Selection

Admission will be taken on the basis of qualifying test and interview as per C.B.S.E. Bye Laws. Applications are invited for admission to class Nur. to VIII and XI. However, the admission depends on the availability of seats. The qualifying tests will be conducted in the school campus itself. The test paper will consist of the following subjects:

For class XI -	(i) English	(ii) Mathematics
	(iii) Biology	(iv) Physics
	(v) Chemistry	(vi) Economics
For class I to X	(i) English	(ii) Mathematics
	(iii) General Studies	

The test will be in English

Note :

- 25% seats are reserved under RTE Act 2009 in our initial class.
- A Security Money of ₹1000/- will have to be deposited at the time of admission. It is refundable only after the student leaves the school finally. If a student leaves the school in the mid session his security money will be refunded to him only after the completion of the session.
- Other detailed information regarding admission and fees can be had from the school office.

Mode of Payment For Day-Scholars

- Students are required to pay their school fee as per our schedule between 1st to 10th of the month without fine.
- Payment of fee with a late fine of ₹100/- is allowed between 11th to 20th of the month.
- Students who fail to pay their fee in the period specified above will have to pay it with an additional fine of ₹150/- for each of the consecutive periods.
- The names of all such students, who fail to pay their fee continuously for three months, will be struck off from the register and if they seek re-admission they will have to pay ₹1000/- as re-admission charge.

Admission To The Hostel

- There are limited seats in the hostel. Students are admitted in the hostel keeping in view the seats available, if applied for in time.
- Boarders are kept under the direct supervision of capable hostel superintendents. They have been given responsibilities of the supervision of studies, health and hygiene of the boarders.
- A security money of ₹3000/- will have to be deposited exclusively for entry in the Hostel.
- A boarder intending to leave the hostel must inform the appropriate authority of his intention two months before leaving it. Otherwise he will have to bear additional hostel charge for two months.
- Security money for hostels is refundable only after the student leaves the school finally to in case of his leaving the hostel in the mean time it will be refundable only after the completion of one-year.



Co-curricular Activities

- Co-curricular activities play a vital role in all round development of a student various co-curricular activities are held in our school.



- We conduct different cultural programmes.
- Various events such as speech, debate, story telling, quiz, antakshari, music, dance etc. are held from time to time.



Attendance

- Students have to attend their classes regularly and punctually.
- Students absent without leave must come with an application giving appropriate reason for the absence duly signed by the guardian.
- As per CBSE by-laws at least 75% attendance in classes held is must for the students, failing which they will not be promoted to higher classes.
- Students have to be present on the closing and the opening day of any vacation or holiday.

Fine For Absence

- A day scholar shall be fined ₹5/- per day for absence without leave.
- A boarder shall be fined at the rate of ₹10/- per day for absence without any prior information. His/her name from the hostel shall be struck off if he/she remains absent for 10 days continuously. He/She will have to seek re-admission after paying the due charges.
- The names of students continuously or discontinuously absent for 7 days in a month without giving prior information will be struck off from the attendance register. Re-admission will be possible only on sufficient ground after consideration on payment of ₹500/- as the re-admission charge. Without re-admission the student will not be allowed in the class.

Examination And Promotion

- The school conducts unit tests and internal assessments during the whole session.
- A student is promoted to the next class on the basis of his/her performance in these tests and assessments.

Conveyance Facility

We provide conveyance facilities also to our students. Details of the route can be had from the office counter.



School Uniform



The school has its own uniform. It has a badge in which the rising sun with its brightness growing intenser symbolizes our small children who, through very tender and delicate, grow into strong men. The Lotus Symbolises our culture and heritage. Underneath is an apology to God to lead us from darkness to light.

Educational Tour

We organise educational tours to the places of historical and cultural importance like Nalanda, Bodh-Gaya, Rajgir, Agra, etc.

Games, Sports, Physical & Health Education

We have experienced and qualified teachers under whose guidance students participate in games, sports and PT.

The school provide facilities for indoor and outdoor games to students.

Parents-teachers Meet

Parents-Teachers Meet is held on the 2nd Saturday every month between 11:30 AM to 12:45 PM.

Code of Conduct For Students

- **The following practices on the part of students strictly forbidden**
 1. Smoking in any form in or outside the school.
 2. The use of drugs or intoxicants.
 3. Any form of gambling.
 4. Disfiguring the school furniture, building or damaging any fittings or fixtures of the school building.
 5. Loitering or noisy behavior in the school premises.
 6. Spitting in or near the school building.
- **The students must show:**
 1. Respect to the members of staff.
 2. when a teacher or a visitor enters a class-room in which the pupils are seated the class will immediately rise up and remain standing until it is asked to be seated.

In addition to these Do's and Don'ts, if any student is found indulging in any other undesirable activity, he/she will be punished accordingly even to the extent of his/her removal from the institution.
